Post-Operative Instructions

MEDICATION

- Prescribed medication should be taken as directed
- Aspirin should NOT be taken for 7 to 10 days following procedure

ACTIVITY

- Activities should be limited for the first 48 hours after the procedure
- You may drive if you are not taking oral narcotics
- The small entry points are closed with suture but will drain. THIS IS NORMAL. The
 drainage will mostly be fluid mixed with a small amount of blood, serum and diluted
 fat
- You may sleep however is comfortable for you
- You may shower after 48 hours. Shower with warm water (not steaming hot, as your skin may be numb). Numbness, swelling and bruising is normal
- Wear your compression garment 23 hours of the day, you may take it off to wash it or to shower
- NO SMOKING

CARE OF SURGICAL SITE

- Keep absorbent pads in place as long as the drainage is present
- Compression garment should be worn for 4 weeks after the procedure

CALL YOUR DOCTOR IF YOU HAVE:

- Pus-like or foul-smelling drainage
- Temperature greater than 100.4
- Excessive bleeding; collections of fluid or blood under the skin (seroma or hematoma)
- Increased pain at the surgical site
- Redness, warmth and excessive swelling of the surgical site
